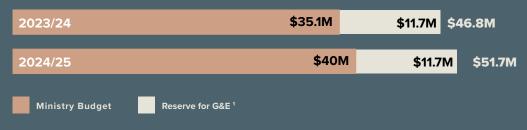

Ministry Staffing (58.30%)

We make disciples, not just converts. Includes all paid personnel at The Summit Church.²

Ministry Programming (24.31%)

We prioritize the gospel above all. Includes campus, central discipleship, weekend experience, and sending.

Ministry Support (17.39%)

We do whatever it takes to reach all people. Includes facilities, administrative systems, and functions.

¹Reserve for Growth and Expansion

Our budget plans for approximately 23% of forecasted total revenue to be allocated toward growth and expansion. We are continually pursuing opportunities to launch new campuses, to renovate and improve existing reserve allows our leaders, working in conjunction with the directional elders, to take advantage of opportuniyear 2024/25 and beyond.

² Staffing

Total staffing-related costs of \$23.3 million, which is approximately 58% of our ministry budget. The standard benchmark for staffing is approximately 55% of cash expenditures.
